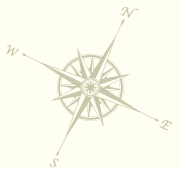




Welcome to the Makino Botanical Garden

Flowering season: early - late March



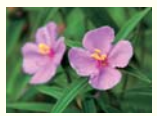
12 *Mucuna sempervirens*

Flowering season: early May - late June

Flowering season: early - late July

Flowering season: mid Aug. - late Sept.
